

Mr. Cummings shared that the community and parent support had not been present prior to his coming to the school and now there were volunteers throughout the building on a daily basis. The discussion then was focused on the kindergarten program at Fellowsville and the fear that the program would be cut at the school. This led to expressed fears about the future of the school and if

the plan was ultimately to close the school. The board assured those present that no discussions had taken place regarding the closing of Fellowsville Elementary.


