

Brain Freeze Activities for Kindergarten - Reading

Two different activities are to be completed for each Brain Freeze day.

<p>Read your favorite book with a special someone.</p>	<p>Practice writing your upper and lower case letters. Tell your parents the name of each letter, the sound, and an object that begins with that sound.</p>	<p>Retell your favorite story to your parents. Be sure to include a beginning, middle, and end.</p>	<p>Draw a picture and write about a favorite book character.</p>
<p>Either write or tell someone the order of events of your day. Example: I woke up. I ate breakfast. I got dressed...</p>	<p>Using abc cereal or abc's you may have at home, put the letters in alphabetical order. Example A, B, C....</p>	<p>Parents: Ask your child to give the beginning, middle and ending sound (not the letter name) of a spoken word. Example: Parent - "red", Student - "r-e-d". Word list: sub, cat, men, log, fan, web, fin, pan, dog, cup, up, tip</p>	<p>Parents: Tell your child the following sentences and have him/her write it: I see a red bird in the snow. The cat has four legs. I like playing in the snow.</p>
<p>Parents: Tell your child to clap the parts (syllables) of the words he/she hears. Use this list: Alligator: (al/i/ga/tor) 4 claps Football: (foot/ball) 2 claps Cake: (cake) 1 clap Calendar: (cal/en/dar) 3 claps Snow: (snow) 1 clap</p>	<p>Tell someone ten words that rhyme with "hot".</p>	<p>Name five words that begin with a short "u" sound. Name five words that begin the short "o" sound.</p>	<p>Write your full name, count the letters, recognize the consonants and vowels, and which name has the most letters.</p>
